

Further to the announcement made by the Chancellor of the Exchequer, there will be a reduction in VAT from 20% to 5% on accommodation, food, non-alcoholic drinks and admission to attractions across the UK from the 15th July 2020 to the 12th July 2021.

Inntel are working with our partners across the supplier network to understand how the reduction in VAT will impact rates for bookings already made and new bookings in this period.

There is no obligation for the venues to reflect the reduction in VAT in their pricing although our Supplier Partnerships Team is encouraging venues to do so in order to stimulate demand.

Many venues are facing financial hardship and some may choose not to reflect the reduction in VAT within their pricing in order to save more jobs within their organisation.

Our Supplier Partnerships Team and our Inntel consultants are reviewing all existing bookings and will amend either the rate or the VAT element or both if applicable and will send you a new confirmation in due course.

For meetings and events bookings, there will be significant impact as DDR (Day Delegate Rate) and Residential packages will show a breakdown per element in the proposal or confirmation as a different VAT rate is charged on each element. Room hire charges, equipment hire and other ancillary services are not included in the VAT reduction.
